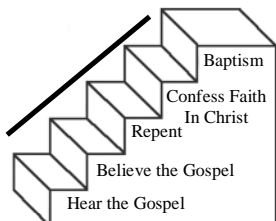

And others fell upon the thorns; and the thorns grew up and choked them: and others fell upon the good ground, and yielded fruit, some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. He that hath ears, let him hear" (Mat 13:1-9).

God will be honored as we gather together worshipping and sanctifying Him in our hearts. Each person who attends will join us in giving God praise.

It is always a blessing to be with those of like precious faith. Our prayers, songs and presence helps.
