

God's Word

Upon the threshold of the new millennium, we are faced with a choice. Do we believe that the Bible is inspired? This truth requires a discussion from the evidence, both internal and external. We must be concerned about the answers.

The Scriptures are inspired by the Holy Spirit and are the revealed will of God, which is the mind of God in human terms, given to guide unto all truth (2 Pet 1:20,21; 2 Tim 3:16,17). There can be no doubt that the New Testament upholds the authenticity and integrity of the Old Testament. The present trend of Postmodernism is to advance human philosophy over the Bible. Postmodernists say that what is produced by man's mind is authoritative. When man will not accept the Bible unless it is confirmed by philosophy it is no longer a matter of faith. When the postmodernists ask for proof of the Bible, they want satisfactory evidence for their philosophies. Man has a love for life and dread of death. Unlike any other creature, man does not like the idea that he was born to die. Man's nature seeks to live beyond the limited life span upon the earth. He yearns for a revelation of his origin and destiny. The Bible is the only book that reveals man's destiny. It is the only book that meets the philosopher's demands, "why am I here and where am I going?"

Man wants to worship and worship requires a Being worthy of worship. This Being must be super-human for man will not worship his inferior or mere equal. The object of worship must be superior to man. Man cannot create such a Being. Therefore, it renders man incapable of creating or imagining an ideal like God. A true object of worship must be revealed. The Bible is the only book that reveals such a Being.

We are not left with mere philosophical evidence of the infallibility of the Bible. Jesus demonstrated with many infallible proofs that he had risen from the dead (Acts 1:3). Such proofs were not dependent on philosophical evidences. The revelation of God's will required many unmistakable

proofs. The certainty of historical events confirms God's word. "Forasmuch as many have taken in hand to draw up a narrative concerning those matters which have been fulfilled among us, even as they delivered them unto us, who from the beginning were eyewitnesses and ministers of the word, it seemed good to me also, having traced the course of all things accurately from the first, to write unto thee in order, most excellent Theophilus; that thou mightest know the certainty concerning the things wherein thou was instructed" (Lk 1:1-4). The perfect understanding and certainty with which New Testament writers wrote as eyewitnesses points to superhuman oversight.

The enemies of Christianity seek to destroy the word and the miracles that confirmed it. Miracles invaded the fixed order of the natural laws and proved that there was a power beyond natural laws. Miracles do not violate natural laws but demonstrate that the Author of such laws has power over and above them. The miracles of the Bible are infallible proofs of its divine origin.

The unique presentation and anticipation of historical events wherein miracles were worked demonstrates God's will is verified only in the Bible (Heb 2:1-5). Joseph in Egypt and the divine revelation of the years of plenty and of famine were anticipated and beyond human intervention and understanding. anticipation of the Bible concerning historical events an infallible proof. Realms of science, archaeology, oceanography, anthropology, meteorology, astronomy, gravity, hydrology and many other sciences were foreknown and predicted in the Bible before they became household terms in society. These were advance statements of divine knowledge in the Bible. They could not be applied until man came upon avenues to discover and employ them. Men of the Bible were not men of science and could not have written or spoken of items beyond the realm of human knowledge without supernatural aid.

The teachings of the New Testament are not of mere men. They sought no earthly aggrandizement, were able to display nonpartisanship even to their fellow Christians. When bonds and afflictions awaited them, they proceeded boldly and confirmed what they said by miracles that were irrefutable. Such words, actions and miracles could not be accounted for except they were of God. (Notes from: Foy Wallace's, God's Prophetic Word)

A breakdown and ruination cannot be far away when the false preachers cry for peace with Satan and his workers calling for an end to spiritual warfare with spiritual hosts of wickedness and unfruitful works of darkness. America has rejected God because too many preachers will not take up moral and spiritual issues. Too many preachers seek to tickle ears, embracing only half-truths and turning aside to fables.

In the battle being fought for the souls of mankind and our nation, political correctness is a false slogan. Fall From Grace?

Comfort is a constant theme in the Bible. Countless events illustrate how God comforts and brings security to the heart of His obedient child. Security in the believer's life is based upon God's declaration of atonement by the blood of Jesus.

All informed children of God understand promises are conditional and to receive them one must comply with God's conditions (Jn 3:14, 15). A "heart of unbelief" can beset and prevent one from entering into the rest of God (Heb 3:7-19). Demonstrated is a condition that makes one aware of the need to be faithfully obedient (Rom 1:1-5; 16:26).

Paul raises the problem of falling from grace (Gal 5:2-12) and identifies those who trouble a Christian as one who struggles to remain faithful and run the race. Sin has many avenues by which it seeks to reemerge in one's life (Lk 8:4-15). The advantage a Christian has is admitting sin, repenting, confessing it and asking for forgiveness (1 Jn 1:8-10). When contemplating the gravity of sin, self-deception and the need to confess sin a Christian is faced with a real life and death struggle. There are <u>public sins</u> that bring the Christian, the Lord and the church into reproach-what is to be done? There are <u>private sins</u> which none but the Lord know-what is to be done? Can sin destroy fellowship with God?

False teachers have duped millions by teaching a Christian cannot fall from grace. If such is true, why are there so many exhortations to beware of philosophy, traditions of men and deceit that are not after Christ (Col 2:8-19)? The issue is not whether an obedient child will be lost. He will not! The issue is can a believer become an unbeliever? Christians are warned to "beware lest anyone take you captive" (Col 2:7, 8). They are admonished to take heed lest they fall (1 Cor 10:1-13). An unbeliever can become a believer (Mk 16:15, 16). Can the process be reversed and believers become an unbeliever (Heb 6:1-5; 3:19)? Does God take away free moral agency from a Christian?

The doctrine that a child of God cannot fall-once saved always saved- became acceptable through the theology of John Calvin and is patently false. This elaborate theology has five main points.

Total heredity depravity-all are born in sin and completely depraved having inherited Adam's sin. The strange problem is that 1 Tim 2:14 explains that Eve was beguiled first and fell into sin, not Adam. Moreover why didn't Jesus, Adam's descendent, have such sin (Lk 3:23-38).

Unconditional election-God before time chose special individuals to either be saved or lost and none can change their destiny. Why then does the New Testament promote the doctrine of conversion and possibility of salvation for all who will obey the gospel (Eph 1:13, 14; 2 Thes 1:6-9)?

Limited atonement-Christ died but not for all. Only the elect will receive atonement. Why did Peter teach making one's calling and election sure if it was impossible (2 Pet 13-11)? Strange that Calvin said Jesus is partial when the Scriptures teach the reverse.

Irresistible grace- the person who God elects will receive the direct operation the Holy Spirit upon their heart to remove the Adamic sin. This doctrine could not stand if the first (Adamic sin) had not been invented. Moreover, it teaches that one cannot resist this operation of the Spirit. Yet, on Pentecost (Acts 2) thousands refused.

Preservation of the saints-once saved always saved is promoted on the premises that a person had received the direct operation of the Spirit and there has been a miraculous grace of God given so that one can never sin and be eternally lost. Hebrews 6 teaches the opposite. It says one can be a partaker of the Holy Spirit and fall away. Beware of false teaches.
